1. **CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL** – Vice Chair, Lieutenant Greg Prestipino, NTAC Director, Nevada State Police, Investigation Division.
2. **WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS** – (Discussion Only) – Vice Chair, Lt. Greg Prestipino. Lt. Prestipino will introduce the new members of the NTAC Advisory Committee: Chief Coley McCann, Nevada Division of Investigations, Chief Kyle Ward, Elko Police Department, and Chief Bob Ryser, Storey County Fire Department.

5. **PRESENTATION AND REVIEW OF NEVADA REVISED STATUTES (NRS) 480.530-480.545 ESTABLISHING THE NEVADA THREAT ANALYSIS CENTER AND THE NTAC ADVISORY COMMITTEE** – (Discussion Only) – Vice Chair, Lt. Greg Prestipino will provide an overview of the role and responsibilities of the Committee, and discuss the statutory requirements for the NTAC, as stated in Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 480.540-480.545.
6. **OVERVIEW AND DISCUSSION OF THE NTAC THREAT LIAISON OFFICER (TLO) PROGRAM AND OUTREACH** – (Discussion Only) – Lt. Greg Prestipino and Dr. Marks will provide the Committee with an update and overview of the NTAC TLO program and outreach initiatives. The TLO program is part of a statewide network of local law enforcement and other NTAC partners who are linked to federal and state assets—designed to provide information sharing.
