Purpose: The Commission receives updated information on the first quarterly report for the period from January to March 2025, which details the statewide adoption and compliance with the National Incident Management System (NIMS), as mandated by Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 239C.310.

Summary: A total of 8,129 students have completed NIMS training facilitated by the Division of Emergency Management (DEM). Of these, 7,777 students engaged in independent study courses, while the remaining 364 students participated in consortium courses, including ICS 300/400 and G/Federal offerings.
